## 11th Revision of the ENCePP Guide; Released July 13,2023

- The structure of the Guide has been revisited to better illustrate the evidence generation flow and to increase the emphasis on important methodology
- The use of the causal inference target trial emulation approach and the estimand framework, and the use of the HARPER protocol template is recommended to foster transparency and high quality of noninterventional studies, and to facilitate their assessment
- Foreword highlighting the continued involvement of ENCePP in sound pharmacoepidemiological research including COVID-19 topics





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
- Update of each chapter by the corresponding authors
  - Chapter 9 on Research networks for multi-database studies addresses the expansion and use of DARWIN EU®
  - Chapter 16.1 on Comparative effectiveness research has been extensively revised
  - Chapter 16.5 on Artificial intelligence has been extensively revised
  - Chapter 16.6 on RWE and pharmacoepidemiology has been extensively revised
