# Guide on Methodological Standards in Pharmacoepidemiology (2)

Survey on use of the guidance to be organised

- Ask investigators about use/usefulness of the Guidance, most useful sections, areas for improvements, etc...
  - Survey investigators, regulators, ENCePP members, manufacturers associations
- ENCePP questionnaire automatically sent to survey the usefulness of the guidance

# Development of an ENCePP Guide on data integration and pooling of pharmacoepidemiological studies

- WG1 supports the initiative and proposed drafting group
- WG1 has the experience. Studies in Nordic countries. Encourage participants in study to collaborate with initiative
- WG1 members are willing to participate as individual reviewers.
- Role of WG1 as a whole unclear at this stage

# ENCePP checklist

- First priority for ENCePP WG1
- Modify the ENCePP checklist according to new template of PASS protocol submission (some differences in the two documents)

# Accreditation system

- Look at other countries accreditation systems
- Look at EMA accreditation for specific projects (financial)
- Is there a need for accreditation? Is there a way of doing so? Is a more formal process needed apart from current level of information provided in ENCePP registry database?



# Training needs

- Encourage members of ENCePP (Eu2P) to reference ENCePP guidelines and codes and deliverables in their training.
