## WHY?

- Promote networking and collaboration between the Italian centres active in the field of Pharmacovigilance and Pharmacoepidemiology
- Promote networking and collaboration between the Italian centres and EMA/ENCePP/other national networks/centres
- Enhance the role of Italian centres in Italy, both at scientific and institutional level: create a stable and strong network with Italian Drug Agency and Regional department of health not only on individual basis but also as community with the final goal of orientating drug policies through RWE generation
- Promote post-graduate education in pharmacovigilance and pharmacoepidemiology, involving the scientific societies active in the field (elevate regulatory sciences)
- Promote regulatory science interactions among key scientific societies for education program

### HOW?

- Invite new centres to join ENCePP
- Promote active participation of the Italian centres in ENCePP, e.g. PAS register, study seal WGs, SIGs, SG
- Raise awareness among Italian centres of opportunities in Europe (e.g. collaboration, funding, accreditation/certification system)
- Disseminate information about Italian excellences in Europe (e.g. RWE based on administrative data, registries, electronic health records)
- Represent Italian pharmacoepidemiologists as a group with one voice, e.g. share position papers, relate to institutions (e.g. regional, national and international authorities)

- TLCs , e.g. feedback from the ENCePP SG
- Mailing list for ad hoc communication from any partner towards the group, e.g. regarding events, funding opportunities etc.
